Group Discussion with Kwetu Girls

1. How was your time at Kwetu Centre? What did you learn?
 - a. It was very good, we learned so much, like how to make chapatti and how to live with adult behaviour and in harmony with others.
 - b. We also learned about HIV/AIDs and how to worship in church. We will continue to worship in church and sing in choir after we leave this place.
 - c. We also learned vocational skills, and spent time at the Centre practising these skills. For instance, the girls who were studying cooking would cook for us.
2. How were the counselling sessions?
 - a. The counselling sessions helped us very much. Now we know how to control ourselves and differentiate between good and bad.
 - b. Now we know about predators and how to say no to them.
 - c. We know that we should be proud of our bodies and that they should not be used in bad ways.
 - d. We also now understand how to speak and behave properly.
3. What was your experience living together as 10 girls?
 - a. We have become very good friends, and it will be very difficult for us to leave each other since we have been living so closely together.
4. Do you feel prepared for life with the skills you have learned?
 - a. Yes, we have learned a lot in our vocational training. Now we are going for field practice placements to gain practical experience. Fter that we will really be prepared.
5. Do you have any comments for me?
 - a. Next time please come earlier and spend more time with the girls at Kwetu so that we can exchange more ideas and share time with you.
